



DO YOU HAVE FAITH?

After Jesus calms the storm in today's Gospel, he asks his terrified disciples, "Do you not yet have faith?" (Mark 4:40). This question is very important for Mark, for he was trying to guide his Gentile audience to faith in the Lord amid Roman persecution. Therefore, he is sure to emphasize how the disciples' faith only gradually overcame their fears. Recall that when the disciples first encountered Jesus, it was a calm, pleasant day by the Sea of Galilee, where they left everything behind to follow him. But now, during a frightening storm with their very lives in danger, their faith wavered. Their strong fear drove out their untested faith. But Jesus' power over the storm, like God's assurance to Job in the first reading, provides an opportunity for their faith in him to overcome their fear of the storm. Our faith is similarly tested by the storms in our lives. We too may feel as if Jesus is sleeping through our trials and hardships. But he remains with us always. He asks us to turn to him in our hour of need, to look to our faith to calm our fears.

How do you find refuge in your faith in times of anxiety or loss?

¿Y TU, TIENES FE?

Después de que Jesús calma la tormenta en el Evangelio de hoy, pregunta a sus aterrorizados discípulos: "¿Aún no tenéis fe?" (Marcos 4:40). Esta pregunta es muy importante para Marcos, porque estaba tratando de guiar a su audiencia Gentil a la fe en el Señor en medio de la persecución romana.

Por lo tanto, seguramente enfatizará cómo la fe de los discípulos solo superó gradualmente sus temores. Recuerde que cuando los discípulos encontraron a Jesús por primera vez, era un día tranquilo y agradable en el Mar de Galilea, donde dejaron todo para seguirlo. Pero ahora, durante una tormenta aterradora con sus vidas en peligro, su fe flaqueó. Su fuerte temor ahuyentó su fe no probada. Pero el poder de Jesús sobre la tormenta, como la seguridad que Dios le dio a Job en la primera lectura, brinda una oportunidad para que su fe en Él supere su miedo a la tormenta. Nuestra fe es igualmente puesta a prueba por las tormentas en nuestras vidas. Nosotros también podemos sentir como si Jesús estuviera durmiendo durante nuestras pruebas y dificultades. Pero él permanece con nosotros siempre. Nos pide que recurramos a Él en nuestra hora de necesidad, que recurramos a nuestra fe para calmar nuestros miedos.

THE MASS • LA MISA

RESPONSORIAL PSALM

For Every Condition and Time

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal indicates that the Responsorial Psalm should be sung, and that if “the Psalm cannot be sung, then it should be recited in a way that is particularly suited to fostering meditation on the Word of God” (GIRM, no. 61). We typically repeat a refrain in between the verses. The refrain gives a brief line for meditation, summarizing a theme of a particular Psalm. Speaking of the Psalms, the Catechism states, “Prayed and fulfilled in Christ, the Psalms are an essential and permanent element of the prayer of the Church. They are suitable for men of every condition and time” (CCC, no. 2597).

Speaking of the use of Psalms in earlier times, the Catechism notes, “The Psalms both nourished and expressed the prayer of the People of God gathered during the great feasts at Jerusalem and each Sabbath in the synagogues. Their prayer is inseparably personal and communal; it concerns both those who are praying and all men” (CCC, no. 2586). The Psalms still have great value for us as well. “Whether hymns or prayers of lamentation or thanksgiving, whether individual or communal, whether royal chants, songs of pilgrimage or wisdom-meditations, the Psalms are a mirror of God’s marvelous deeds in the history of his people, as well as reflections of the human experience of the Psalmist [the person writing the Psalm]. Though a given psalm may reflect an event of the past, it still possesses such direct simplicity that it can be prayed in truth by men of all times and conditions” (CCC, no. 2588).

Jesus Prayed the Same Words

Charles Belmonte reminds us to sing the Psalms with faith and joy, recalling the exhortation of St. Paul: “St. Paul recommends that the faithful gathered waiting for the coming of the Lord sing together psalms, hymns, and spiritual canticles (see Col 3:16). The heart shows its joy by singing. Thus St. Augustine says rightly, ‘to sing belongs to lovers.’ There is also the ancient proverb: ‘One who sings well prays twice’”

(Understanding the Mass, p. 88).

I appreciate thinking of how our Lord Jesus would have also sung and prayed these same words in the Psalms. Since we know from the Gospels that he regularly went to the Jewish prayer gatherings, we can conclude that he would also have sung the Psalms regularly. There were times he referred directly to the Psalms, such as when he started praying

Psalm 22 from the Cross:

“My God, My God, why have you abandoned me?”

It doesn’t get much better than spending a little time with the Lord using the exact words he used to pray. The next time you have 20 seconds to spare, try praying Psalm 117. If you have 20 minutes, check out a longer passage, like Psalm 119. If you are really feeling bold, try to sing one, whether at Church, working outside, or in the shower.

It is always “good to praise the Lord!” (Psalm 92:1)

SALMO RESPONSORIAL

Para Cada Condición y Momento

La Instrucción General del Misal Romano indica que se debe cantar el Salmo Responsorial, y que si “el Salmo no se puede cantar, entonces se debe recitar de una manera que sea particularmente adecuada para fomentar la meditación en la Palabra de Dios” (IGMR, núm. 61). Normalmente repetimos un estribillo entre versos. El estribillo ofrece una breve línea para la meditación, que resume un tema de un salmo en particular.

Hablando de los Salmos, el Catecismo afirma: “Orados y cumplidos en Cristo, los Salmos son un elemento esencial y permanente de la oración de la Iglesia. Son apropiadas para hombres de toda condición y época”

(CIC, no. 2597).

Hablando del uso de los Salmos en épocas anteriores, el Catecismo señala: “Los Salmos alimentaron y expresaron la oración del Pueblo de Dios reunido durante las grandes fiestas en Jerusalén y cada sábado en las sinagogas. Su oración es inseparablemente personal y comunitaria; concierne tanto a los que oran como a todos los hombres” (CIC, no. 2586). Los Salmos también tienen un gran valor para nosotros. “Ya sean himnos u oraciones de lamentación o acción de gracias, individuales o comunitarias, cantos reales, cánticos de peregrinación o meditaciones de sabiduría, los Salmos son un espejo de las maravillas de Dios en la historia de su pueblo, así como reflejos de la experiencia humana del salmista [la persona que escribe el Salmo]. Aunque un salmo determinado pueda reflejar un acontecimiento del pasado, posee sin embargo una sencillez tan directa que puede ser rezado en verdad por hombres de todos los tiempos y condiciones”

(CIC, no. 2588).

Jesús Oró las Mismas Palabras

Carlos Belmonte nos recuerda cantar los Salmos con fe y alegría, recordando la exhortación de San Pablo: “St. Pablo recomienda que los fieles reunidos esperando la venida del Señor canten juntos salmos, himnos y cánticos espirituales (ver Col 3:16). El corazón muestra su alegría cantando. Por eso dice con razón San Agustín: ‘Cantar es de los amantes’. También está el antiguo proverbio: ‘Quien canta bien, reza dos veces’”. (Entendiendo la Misa, p. 88).

Agradezco pensar en cómo nuestro Señor Jesús también habría cantado y orado estas mismas palabras en los Salmos. Como sabemos por los Evangelios que asistía regularmente a las reuniones de oración judías, podemos concluir que también habría cantado los Salmos con regularidad. Hubo momentos en que se refirió directamente a los Salmos, como cuando comenzó a orar. Salmo 22 desde la Cruz:

“Dios mío, Dios mío, ¿por qué me has abandonado?”

No hay nada mejor que pasar un poco de tiempo con el Señor usando las mismas palabras que él usó para orar. La próxima vez que tengas 20 segundos libres, intenta rezar el Salmo 117. Si tienes 20 minutos, lee un pasaje más largo, como el Salmo 119. Si realmente te sientes audaz, intenta cantar uno, ya sea en la iglesia, trabajando afuera, o en la ducha.

¡Siempre es “bueno alabar al Señor!” (Salmo 92:1)


