



FAITH IN ACTION

Of Jesus' visit to his hometown, Mark says, "He was amazed at their lack of faith" (Mark 6:6).

Recall, he had just encountered two people of extremely strong faith: the woman with hemorrhages and the synagogue official whose daughter was near death. Jesus healed the woman and raised the child, as we heard last week. Jesus remarked upon the faith of both, faith that the two made visible by turning to the Lord in their time of need. This is the kind of faith that Jesus calls us to have: one that we give witness to in the way we live our lives, make our choices, and treat others. The people of Nazareth, however, showed no faith, "So he was not able to perform any mighty deed there" (Mark 6:5). Yet Jesus cures a few sick people before departing. Even among an unbelieving people, Jesus' grace changes lives. His healing touch, his loving presence, his redemptive suffering, can penetrate even weak or wavering faith. May today's Gospel be a consolation to us.

FE EN ACCIÓN

De la visita de Jesús a su ciudad natal, Marcos dice: "Quedó asombrado de su falta de fe" (Marcos 6:6). Recordemos que acababa de encontrarse con dos personas de fe extremadamente fuerte: la mujer con hemorragias y el funcionario de la sinagoga cuya hija estaba al borde de la muerte.

Jesús sanó a la mujer y sanó al niño, como escuchamos la semana pasada. Jesús destacó la fe de ambos, fe que los dos hicieron visible al volverse al Señor en su momento de necesidad. Este es el tipo de fe que Jesús nos llama a tener: una fe de la que damos testimonio en la forma en que vivimos nuestras vidas, tomamos decisiones y tratamos a los demás. El pueblo de Nazaret, sin embargo, no mostró fe: "Y no pudo hacer allí ningún milagro" (Marcos 6:5). Sin embargo, Jesús cura a algunos enfermos antes de partir. Incluso entre un pueblo incrédulo, la gracia de Jesús cambia vidas. Su toque sanador, su presencia amorosa, su sufrimiento redentor pueden penetrar incluso la fe débil o vacilante. Que el Evangelio de hoy sea un consuelo para nosotros.

RESPONSE AFTER READINGS

God Speaks to Us

Far more than just being “standard operating procedure,” these little dialogues are really powerful affirmations of what is happening during the Liturgy of the Word. While the lector proclaims God’s Word, we listen to what God wants to teach us that particular day. Even if we are generally attentive to the readings, we can easily get distracted. Perhaps we notice someone sitting nearby and think of a question we wanted to ask him or her. Sometimes, a word in the reading reminds us of another thought. Maybe our stomach growls and we start thinking about what our next meal might be. In any event, at the end of the reading, the lector helps to get us back on track if we’ve wandered astray. The lector says, “The Word of the Lord,” as if to say, “In case you forgot or didn’t notice, the Lord God of heaven and earth was just speaking to you.” It really is amazing to stop and think about: God is speaking to us, his people, through the readings at Mass!

Our response, “Thanks be to God,” acknowledges that God is truly speaking to his people through the Bible reading we just heard and that we recognize we are blessed to hear those words! Being in the habit of turning to God in thankfulness can be so helpful in our daily living as well. In the midst of our lives, we easily get our hearts turned inward, such as when we are thinking about what makes us happy or what we would enjoy for dinner. In more serious situations, when we fall into sin, we are turned inward in a way that keeps our vision away from God and others. When this happens, we can find ourselves falling into selfishness and self-seeking behavior. We can also miss opportunities for charity because we do not recognize the good in the people around us.

Practicing Thankfulness

In these latter situations, the grace of the sacraments helps strengthen us. Thankfulness is also a great remedy that helps turn our hearts as we recognize blessings that have come from God and others. Being thankful can give us a reset and help us once again to see and appreciate the gifts God has given us and the good that we can see in one another. We glimpse the wisdom behind our response to the readings at Mass. Being in the habit of regularly thanking God helps keep our hearts healthy and on track.

Not only does this dialogue help us acknowledge God and thank him for the Scriptures, but it can also help us stay in tune with what we are doing at Mass. As you may know, the word Eucharist itself means “thanksgiving.” In the Mass, we join with Christ in the perfect sacrifice of praise to God the Father. As God’s people, we are also joined together in thankful praise, recognizing the love of Christ and our invitation to share in that love. Very fittingly, after the Second Reading and response, we will praise God together in preparation for the Gospel as we sing the Alleluia!

RESPUESTA DESPUÉS DE LAS LECTURAS

Dios Habla con Nosotros

Mucho más que ser simplemente un “procedimiento operativo estándar”, estos pequeños diálogos son afirmaciones realmente poderosas de lo que sucede durante la Liturgia de la Palabra. Mientras el lector proclama la Palabra de Dios, escuchamos lo que Dios quiere enseñarnos ese día en particular. Incluso si generalmente estamos atentos a las lecturas, podemos distraernos fácilmente. Quizás notamos a alguien sentado cerca y pensamos en una pregunta que queríamos hacerle. A veces, una palabra de la lectura nos recuerda otro pensamiento. Quizás nuestro estómago gruñe y empezamos a pensar en cuál podría ser nuestra próxima comida. En cualquier caso, al final de la lectura, el lector nos ayuda a volver al camino correcto si nos hemos desviado. El lector dice: “La Palabra del Señor”, como si dijera: “En caso de que lo hayas olvidado o no lo hayas notado, el Señor Dios del cielo y de la tierra justo te estaba hablando”. Realmente es sorprendente detenerse y pensar: ¡Dios nos está hablando a nosotros, su pueblo, a través de las lecturas de la Misa!

Nuestra respuesta, “Gracias a Dios”, reconoce que Dios realmente le está hablando a su pueblo a través de la lectura de la Biblia que acabamos de escuchar y que reconocemos que somos bendecidos al escuchar esas palabras. Tener el hábito de acudir a Dios en agradecimiento también puede ser muy útil en nuestra vida diaria. En medio de nuestras vidas, fácilmente hacemos que nuestro corazón se vuelva hacia adentro, como cuando pensamos en lo que nos hace felices o en lo que disfrutaríamos en la cena. En situaciones más serias, cuando caemos en pecado, nos volvemos hacia adentro de una manera que mantiene nuestra visión alejada de Dios y de los demás. Cuando esto sucede, podemos encontrarnos cayendo en el egoísmo y en un comportamiento egoísta. También podemos perder oportunidades de caridad porque no reconocemos el bien de las personas que nos rodean.

Practicando el Agradecimiento

En estas últimas situaciones, la gracia de los sacramentos nos ayuda a fortalecernos. El agradecimiento también es un gran remedio que ayuda a cambiar nuestro corazón al reconocer las bendiciones que han venido de Dios y de los demás. Ser agradecido puede darnos un reinicio y ayudarnos una vez más a ver y apreciar los regalos que Dios nos ha dado y el bien que podemos ver unos en otros. Vislumbramos la sabiduría detrás de nuestra respuesta a las lecturas de la Misa. Tener el hábito de agradecer a Dios con regularidad ayuda a mantener nuestro corazón sano y encaminado.

Este diálogo no solo nos ayuda a reconocer a Dios y agradecerle por las Escrituras, sino que también puede ayudarnos a estar en sintonía con lo que estamos haciendo en la Misa. Como sabrán, la palabra Eucaristía en sí significa “acción de gracias”. En la Misa, nos unimos a Cristo en el sacrificio perfecto de alabanza a Dios Padre. Como pueblo de Dios, también estamos unidos en alabanza agradecida, reconociendo el amor de Cristo y nuestra invitación a compartir ese amor. Muy apropiadamente, después de la segunda lectura y la respuesta, ¡alabaremos juntos a Dios en preparación para el Evangelio mientras cantamos el Aleluya!


